North: — Bothell, Kenmore, Lake Forest Park, Shoreline, Woodinville

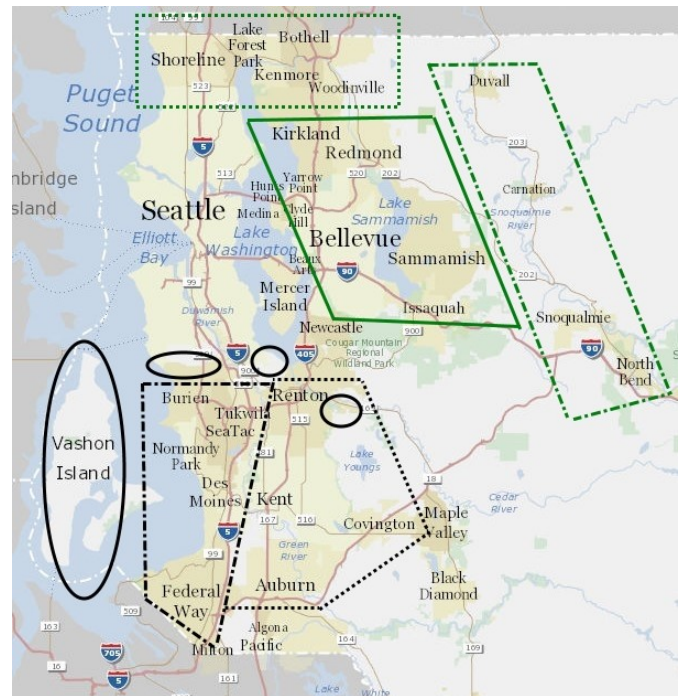
East: — Bellevue, Issaquah, Kirkland, Redmond, Sammamish
